## GENEALOGY - ADVANCED SEARCH

- The Advanced Search will always be available at bottom of the page with possible results and can be particularly used when no records are found:

**ADVANCED SEARCH** \* Compulsary fields

- For names such as MacCarthy, McCarthy or Mc Carthy, ... use the "Contains" Option in the Last Name dropdown and only type part of the name of which you are sure, example "Carthy":

- To narrow down search results, enter only part of the address, example street name, that you are sure about without house number, commas, or "street", "road"

Example: 69 Dorset Street, could be entered in the database as "69, Dorset Street" or "Dorset Street, 69" or "69 Dorset st." So when searching for this address, "Dorset" is the only part of address that remains consistent:
