Removal and re-setting of monuments, kerbing and covering stones to facilitate burials.

In order to facilitate the opening of graves, and to comply with Health & Safety regulations, interments can only take place if there is confirmation from the deceased family that Glasnevin Trust can proceed to remove and re-instate any memorials or kerbing on the grave which may have become damaged, disjointed, loose or unstable (and if applicable adjoining graves).

There is a charge for this service and you will be notified of the total charge for the grave opening, as part of the Request of Burial Service Form, no later than 2.00pm on the day prior to the burial.

If a signed Request of Burial Service Form is not received by Glasnevin Trust by 4.00pm on the day prior to the burial accepting all charges then the grave cannot be opened.

All works are carried out by Glasnevin Trust.

Included in the burial fee:

1. Standard opening fee at the time of being.
2. 1 years grave maintenance (surface only).

In addition the following charges may apply:

- i) Any charge for removal and reset of monument / kerbing.
- ii) Any temporary headstones (not on a foundation) will be re-set. Foundation fees will apply.
- iii) It may be necessary to remove the monuments and/or kerbing/covering stone from adjoining graves to facilitate burials, there will be a charge for such works.

Charges will vary according to the amount of work involved. The Funeral Director arranging the burial will be informed of all charges prior to any works taking place.

All re-instatement works will be completed within 60 days of the burial date.

Maintenance of the grave and headstone thereafter is the responsibility of the grave owner.

Kerbing is not permitted on single (8ft x 2ft) graves, and will be removed.
